WHEREAS, Indigo Community Development District (the "District") is a local unit of special-purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*, being situated entirely within the County of Volusia, Florida; and

BOND COUNSEL AGREEMENT

This Bond Counsel Agreement is entered into as of the 1st day of April, 2021, by and between **INDIGO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT**, a community development district organized and existing under the provisions of Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, as amended (the "District"), and **BRYANT MILLER OLIVE P.A.**, a Florida professional service corporation ("BMO").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the District plans to issue its revenue bonds (the "Bonds") to finance or refinance the acquisition, construction and equipping of certain capital improvements benefiting landowners of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to engage BMO as bond counsel in connection with the issuance and sale of the obligations including Bonds, on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, BMO desires to accept engagement as bond counsel for the District in connection with the issuance and sale of the Bonds, on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, which shall be deemed an integral part of this Agreement, and of the covenants and agreements herein contained, the District and BMO, both intending to be legally bound hereby, agree as follows:

1. BOND COUNSEL

- **1.1.** *Duties of Bond Counsel.* BMO shall serve as bond counsel to the District in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. It is anticipated that such Bonds will be sold through a negotiated sale or private placement. The duties of BMO as bond counsel shall include the following:
 - 1.1.1. Prepare or review all indentures (including a Master Indenture and Supplemental Indenture) with respect to the Bonds, and other documents relating to the Bonds, said duty to be performed in cooperation with the financial advisors and/or underwriters/placement agents engaged by the District.
 - 1.1.2. Review all disclosure documents, including official statements, prepared or authorized by the District insofar as such documents contain descriptions of the Bonds and summaries of contracts or other documents relevant to the Bonds; provided, however, that BMO shall have no responsibility for the disclosure documents insofar as such documents describe the financial circumstances of the offering or any other statistical projects or data, and provided further, that BMO shall have no responsibility to the purchasers of the Bonds for state or federal securities law compliance in

connection with the offering of the Bonds.

- 1.1.3. Prepare all closing documents, and attend and be responsible for the closing, as well as attending drafting and informational meetings regarding the Bonds.
- 1.1.4. Render opinions in written form at the time the Bonds are to be authenticated and delivered, which opinions shall cover the legality of the Bonds and the exemption of the interest to be paid with respect to the Bonds from federal income taxation.
- 1.2 Duties of Bond Counsel under this engagement are limited to those expressly set forth above. Among other things, Bond Counsel's duties do not include:
 - 1.2.1 Preparation of an official statement or any other disclosure document with respect to the public offering of tax exempt debt obligations, or performing an independent investigation to determine the accuracy, completeness or sufficiency of any such document or rendering advice that the official statement or other disclosure document does not contain any untrue statement of a material fact or omit to state a material fact necessary to make the statements contained therein, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading.
 - 1.2.2 Preparing blue sky or investment surveys with respect to the debt instrument.
 - 1.2.3 Drafting state constitutional or legislative amendments.
 - 1.2.4 Pursuing test cases or other litigation (such as validation proceedings).
 - 1.2.5 Making an investigation or expressing any view as to the creditworthiness of the District, any credit enhancement provider, liquidity provider or the debt instrument.
 - 1.2.6 Assisting in the preparation of, or opining on, a continuing disclosure undertaking pertaining to any publicly offered debt or, after Closing, providing advice concerning any actions necessary to assure compliance with any continuing disclosure undertaking.
 - 1.2.7 Representing the District in Internal Revenue Service examinations or inquiries, or Securities and Exchange Commission investigations.
 - 1.2.8 After Closing, providing continuing advice to the District or any other party concerning any actions necessary to assure that interest paid on any tax exempt debt instrument will continue to be excludable from gross income for federal income tax purposes (e.g., this engagement does not include rebate calculations for any tax exempt debt).

- 1.2.9 Providing any advice or opinions on bankruptcy matters.
- 1.2.10 Providing advice or opinions on interest rate swap agreements.
- 1.2.11 Addressing any other matter not specifically set forth above that is not required to render BMO's legal opinions.
- 1.3. Fees and Expenses for Services Rendered as Bond Counsel. Based upon (i) our understanding of the terms, structure, size and schedule of the financing represented by each Series of Bonds; (ii) the duties we will undertake pursuant to this agreement; (iii) the time we anticipate devoting to the financing; and (iv) the responsibilities we will assume in connection therewith, we will submit a fee for your approval prior to the issuance of each series of Bonds. Our fee may vary: (a) if the principal amount of Bonds actually issued differs significantly from the amount originally anticipated; (b) if material changes in the structure or schedule of the financing occur; or (c) if unusual or unforeseen circumstances arise which require a significant increase in our time or responsibility. If, at any time, we believe that circumstances require an adjustment of our original fee, we will advise you and request your prior approval.

The District shall pay to BMO, as a fee for services rendered pursuant to this Section 1, the following sums:

- (a) for services rendered in connection with the issuance of bonds through a public offering of the bonds, an amount of \$45,000 for each such issue; and
- **(b)** for services rendered in connection with the issuance of bonds through a private placement with a single accredited investor, an amount of \$30,000 for each such issue.

The fees shall be paid by the District to BMO from the proceeds derived by the District from the sale of the Bonds and, if the Bonds are not sold, then no fees shall be paid by the District for services rendered pursuant to this Section 1.

The foregoing fees shall not include out-of-pocket expenses incurred by BMO in connection with services rendered hereunder, which shall be payable in addition to said fee in an amount not to exceed \$2,000 per issue

- 1.4 Limitations on Engagement: Unless otherwise expressly stated herein, it is understood and agreed that the District is not relying upon Bond Counsel for investment or accounting advice or decisions, or to investigate the character or credit of any persons with whom you are or may be dealing in connection with this matter.
- 1.5 Waiver of Future Conflicts: It is a condition of BMO's acceptance of this engagement that the District understand and agree that BMO may continue to represent, or may undertake in the future to represent, any existing or future client(s) in any matter which is not substantially related to the particular matter that BMO is handling for the District in this engagement.

- 1.6 Applicability to Future Engagements: Unless a different engagement letter is executed in the future, the terms of this engagement letter will also be applicable to and govern our professional relationship on all subsequent matters on or in which we may become involved or engaged on the District's behalf.
- 2. TERMINATION. This Agreement may be terminated by the District, or by BMO, with or without cause, upon fifteen (15) days prior written notice to the other. If the District terminates BMO for reasonable cause related to the District's dissatisfaction with the quality of the services rendered by BMO (such as, for example, BMO's failure to meet reasonable deadlines imposed by the District, BMO's neglect of its duties hereunder, or BMO's improper performance of its duties hereunder), then no compensation shall be paid to BMO for any services theretofore rendered pursuant to Section 1 of this Agreement. If the District terminates BMO for any other reason, but nevertheless sells the Bonds, then compensation to be paid by the District shall be an amount equal to the number of hours devoted by BMO to its services as bond counsel pursuant to Section 1 above through the termination date multiplied by \$350.00.
- **3. CONSTRUCTION**. This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Florida.
- 4. **CONFLICTS**. The rules regulating The Florida Bar provide that common representation of multiple parties is permissible where the clients are generally aligned in interest, even though there is some difference in interest among them. BMO is disclosing to the District that it has, and may in the future, serve as bond or disclosure counsel to other local governments or otherwise act as underwriter's counsel or trustee's counsel on public finance matters in Florida. From time to time, BMO may represent the firms which may underwrite the District's bonds, notes or other obligations (including MBS Capital Markets, LLC, U.S. Bank National Association and other financial institutions hired by the District) on financings for other governmental entities in Florida on unrelated matters. In either case, such representations are standard and customary within the industry and BMO can effectively represent the District and the discharge of BMO's professional responsibilities to the District will not be prejudiced as a result, either because such engagements will be sufficiently different or because the potential for such prejudice is remote and minor and outweighed by consideration that it is unlikely that advice given to the other client will be relevant in any respect to the subject matter, and the District expressly consents to such other representations consistent with the circumstances herein described. We have represented and currently represent landowners that have purchased land with delinquent special assessments, including INA Group, LLC, with negotiations with the District's bondholders to settle outstanding amounts due on the District's outstanding Series 1999 and Series 2005 Bonds. We have worked with your counsel and district manager to negotiate these settlements.

The District acknowledges and agrees that BMO's role as bond counsel, disclosure counsel, counsel to any local governmental entity or financial institution or in conjunction with public finance transactions or settlement negotiations with landowners that have purchased

land with delinquent special assessments is not likely to create or cause any actual conflict, and service as disclosure, bond, or counsel to other clients of BMO will not per se be construed as a conflict or be objectionable to the District.

Please understand that while we cannot, and do not, guarantee the outcome or success of this or any other engagement or professional undertaking, we will earnestly strive to represent and serve the District's interests in this engagement effectively, efficiently and responsively while endeavoring to accomplish its objectives in this engagement.

The regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Indigo Community Development District was held Wednesday, March 24, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. in the Holiday Inn Daytona Beach LPGA Boulevard, Ballroom, 137 Automall Circle, Daytona Beach, Florida.

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS Roll Call

Mr. Perry called the meeting to order and called the roll.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS Public Comments

Mr. Kralijev gave an overview of the LPGA Phase 1 project consisting of 195 homesites in the first phase and read into the record a letter from their project engineer regarding the stormwater management system.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS Approval of the Minutes of the January 27, 2021 Meeting

On MOTION by Mr. Parks seconded by Mr. McCommon with all in favor the minutes of the January 27, 2021 meeting were approved as presented.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Ratification of E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding

Mr. Perry stated we are required to work with the Department of Homeland Security in regard to E-Verify. Fortunately, for this district you don't have any employees, so it is moot, but we still have to file acknowledgement of that. The only thing that does apply is if we have issues with any of our vendors if we believe there are personnel that are not qualified under E-Verify; they are supposed to qualify their employees.

On MOTION by Mr. Parks seconded by Mr. McCarthy with all in favor the registration in the E-Verify system was ratified.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Moving May Meeting to May 12, 2021

On MOTION by Mr. Parks seconded by Mr. McCommon with all in favor the May meeting was moved to May 12, 2021.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Updated Interlocal Agreement with the Volusia County Property Appraiser for Collection of Non-Ad Valorem Assessments

Mr. Perry stated this is a standard agreement, there have been some changes with the county charter and with the sheriff and tax collector and as a result of that this agreement was updated. It doesn't change any material items at all, the fees are the same and they want a new agreement signed with them. We have signed it every year and we would look for a motion to approve.

On MOTION by Mr. Kilian seconded by Mr. McCarthy with all in favor the interlocal agreement with the Volusia County property appraiser was approved.

SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Staff Reports

A. District Counsel

There being none, the next item followed.

B. District Engineer

There being none, the next item followed.

C. District Manager

Mr. Perry stated we are starting the preliminary work on the budget for next year. We will probably approach it in the same manner that we did in the previous couple of years where we are not going to have an assessment increase and we will look to see if we can reduce assessments going forward. It looks favorable at this point in time.

D. Field Operational Manager

Mr. von der Osten stated the work has begun on Champions Drive by the City of Daytona Beach. As of this morning I spoke with the public works department, the project manager, it is on schedule and has a 60-day completion date and if the weather holds out it will be fine. They are going through and replacing much of the sidewalks and as they encounter any irrigation problem, electrical problems they have contact information for Rountree and Courteaux Electric. I gave them plenty of warning that there are buried junction boxes out there and I think they found one irrigation box so far. Once they finish the sidewalks they come back and do the milling and resurfacing on the main road. They do plan to remove the pavers, although the CDD installed those they were dedicated to the City of Daytona Beach, so they plan to come back with a stamped asphalt. It might not be immediate, evidently there are issues with supply. The milling and paving is about a 10-day process, it takes longer than the sidewalks; the tree work, they are grinding some roots trying to be attentive to the trees.

Mr. Rountree stated we have only had one irrigation break. As far as them damaging the oak trees, the likelihood of them killing an oak tree is slim to none. The only contingent that you have is if you weaken the root system enough that it can come down in a storm. They are not going deep enough to affect the root system. I don't foresee any problems. We are going to have irrigation breaks.

Mr. von der Osten stated the next item is the I-95 Interchange; it has been very active with the construction of Buc-ee's and they are wrapping up. They did cause some damage to the CDD improvements, irrigation and landscaping, they have worked with Team Rountree and have funded replacement and repair of the damages. There are additional repairs to be done and we are putting the list together to present to the contractor for repair reimbursement. A large irrigation main break

caused a lot of erosion on the bank, but that can't definitively be attributed to any particular party; we have had it happen in the past also with pressure fluctuations from the water plant.

Mr. Rountree stated the next annual rotation is scheduled, but we will probably not do the front entrance until the city work is completed because I can't turn the water back on so you will probably see the monuments at the back entrance, both ends of Tournament Drive changed until they start to cook in the heat, we will probably pull them out and leave it bare.

EIGHTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Supervisors Requests and Audience Comments

Mr. Parks asked do you know what is going on with Greyhawk II?

Mr. von der Osten stated the for sale sign on LPGA is not Greyhawk II, it is only the parcel for the entrance.

Mr. McCommon asked what about the developer for 21?

Mr. von der Osten stated it was under contract the last I heard.

- 2. **SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING.** A public hearing on said approved Proposed Budget is hereby declared and set for the following date, hour and location:

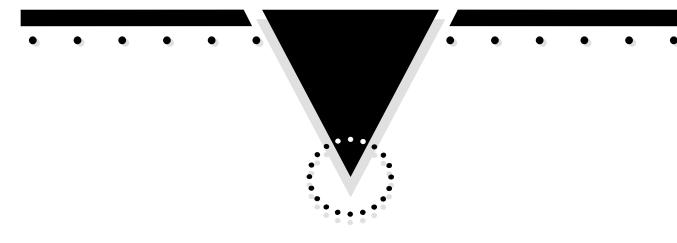

- 5. **PUBLICATION OF NOTICE.** Notice of this public hearing shall be published in the manner prescribed in Florida law.
- 6. **SEVERABILITY.** The invalidity or unenforceability of any one or more provisions of this Resolution shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining portions of this Resolution, or any part thereof.
- 7. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

REVENUES:

Maintenance Assessments

The District will levy a Non-Ad Valorem Assessment on all taxable property within the Indigo Community Development District in order to pay for operating & maintenance expenditures for the Fiscal Year.

Interest Income

The District will have operating funds invested with the US Bank throughout the fiscal year.

I-95 City of Daytona Funding

Represents mowing cost reimbursement from the City of Daytona for 27 cuts at the I-95 interchange per interlocal agreement.

Administrative:

Supervisors Fees

The amount paid to each supervisor for the time devoted to District business and meetings is determined by Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, at \$200 per meeting. The amount is based on payment to 5 Supervisors for attending 12 Board meetings during the fiscal year.

FICA Expense

Represents the Employer's share of Social Security and Medicare taxes withheld from Board of Supervisors checks.

Engineering

The District's engineer will be providing general engineering services to the District, i.e., attendance and preparation for monthly meetings, reviewing invoices, annual engineer's report and various projects assigned as directed by the Board of Supervisors.

Attorney

The District's attorney will be providing general legal services to the District, i.e., attendance and preparation for monthly meetings, reviewing contracts, agreements, resolutions, etc. Included as a separate line item is the estimated portion of foreclosure costs related primarily to non-payment of assessments on undeveloped lands in the "South" area of the District. Approximately 75% of the costs will be funded by bond funds.

Annual Audit

The District is required to annually have its financial records audited by an independent Certified Public Accounting Firm.

Arbitrage

The District has a contract to annually calculate the District's Arbitrage Rebate Liability on the Series 1999A, 1999 C and 2005 Capital Improvement Revenue Bonds. The amount is based on the current contract with AMTEC.

Trustee Fees

The District's Series 1999A, 1999C and 2005 Capital Improvement Revenue Bonds are held with a Trustee at US Bank.

Dissemination Agent

The District is required by the Security and Exchange Commission to comply with Rule 15c2-12(b)(5), which relates to additional reporting requirements for unrelated bond issues. The District has contracted with Governmental Management Services, LLC to provide this service and the amount is based on the contracted amount.

Special Assessment Roll Services

The District has contracted with Governmental Management Services, LLC for administration and certification of its annual assessment roll.

Management Fees

The District has contracted with Governmental Management Services, LLC to provide Management, Accounting and Recording Secretary Services for the District. The services include, but not limited to, recording and transcription of board meetings, administrative services, budget preparation, all financial reporting, annual audits, etc. Included as a separate line item is the estimated portion of foreclosure costs related primarily to non- payment of assessments on undeveloped lands.

Information Technology

Represents cost related to District's information systems, which include but are nt limited to video conferencing services, cloud storage services and servers, security, accounting software, etc.

Website Maintenance

Represents the costs associated with monitoring and maintaining the District's website created in accordance with Chapter 189, Florida Statutes. These services include site performance assessments, security and firewall maintenance, updates, document uploads, hosting and domain renewals, website backups, etc.

Telephone

Telephone and fax machine.

Postage

Mailing of Board meeting agendas, checks for vendors, and any other required correspondence.

Insurance

The District currently has a General Liability/Errors & Omissions and Property Insurance Policy with Florida Insurance Alliance (FIA). FIA specializes in providing insurance coverage for Governmental Agencies.

Printing & Binding

Printing and binding agenda packages for board meetings, printing of computerized checks, correspondence, stationary, etc.

Legal Advertising
